A proposed nationwide class action settlement has been reached in a lawsuit against Ford Motor Company. The case concerns model year 2011-2015 Ford Explorer vehicles ("Class Vehicles"). The lawsuit alleges that exhaust odor may enter the passenger compartment of some vehicles due to defects. Ford denies these allegations. This Settlement resolves the case and will pay money to Class Members who submit valid claims.

Who is included? You are a Class Member if you are a current or former owner or lessee of one or more Class Vehicles.

What can I get? Ford has released an updated repair procedure that is available to customers who are experiencing exhaust odor concerns related to the alleged defect. This enhanced procedure is available at no charge for vehicles under warranty. If the Settlement is approved by the Court, and if you submit a Claim Form and supporting documentation, Ford may reimburse you for certain out-of-pocket expenses incurred obtaining repairs to address exhaust odor in your Class Vehicle during a limited period of time following expiration of your vehicle's 3-year/36,000-mile limited written warranty. Maximum available reimbursement amounts will be \$175 or \$500 per repair, depending on the nature of the repair. Ford will reimburse you for up to two such repairs per Class Vehicle. The Long Form Notice fully describes all reimbursement options as well as non-monetary Settlement benefits, such as the potential ability to pursue claims against Ford through the Better Business Bureau. Go to www.ExplorerExhaustSettlement.com to obtain a copy of the Long Form Notice and the TSB.

What are my options? You can stay in the case (by doing nothing right now), exclude yourself, or object to the settlement. The only way to receive a settlement payment is to file a claim. You may not file a claim if you exclude yourself. If the Court approves the settlement and you have not excluded yourself, you will be bound by all the Court's orders and judgments, even if you do not file a claim.

How do I file a claim? If you are a Class Member and you have documentation for your exhaust odor repair(s), you should complete the Claim Form signed under penalty of perjury that will be made available on www.ExplorerExhaustSettlement.com if the Court approves this Settlement.

How do I exclude myself from the Settlement? If you do not want to receive a payment and do not want to be bound by the Settlement, you must exclude yourself by May 17, 2017 by mailing a letter to Ford Settlement Exclusion Center, P.O. Box 43444, Providence RI 02940-3444. Your letter must include all the information specified in the Long Form Notice that is available at www.ExplorerExhaustSettlement.com or by calling 1-855-581-1279. The letter must be received by May 17, 2017 to be deemed timely.

*****If you were a member of the Florida Litigation Class certified in this case, and you excluded yourself from the Litigation Class, you must exclude yourself again if you do not want to receive payment and do not want to be bound by the Settlement.*****

How do I object to the Settlement? If you do not exclude yourself from the Settlement but you wish to object to it, you may object by May 17, 2017 by following the procedures in the Long Form Notice that is available at www.ExplorerExhaustSettlement.com or by calling 1-855-581-1279.

What happens next? The Court, located in Fort Lauderdale, FL, will hold a hearing on June 14, 2017 at 9:00 a.m. on whether to approve the Settlement, including the amount of Class Counsel's attorneys' fees and expenses (up to \$5,000,000 to be paid by Ford) and what Service Award, if any, should be given to the Class Representatives. You or your attorney also may ask permission to speak at the hearing at your own cost.

Who represents me? The Court has appointed attorneys (Jordan Lewis, Esq., of the law firm Jordan Lewis, P.A., and John Uustal, Esq. and Michael Hersh, Esq. of the law firm Kelley Uustal PLC) as Class Counsel to represent the Class. You will not be charged for these attorneys, but you may hire an attorney to represent you at your own expense.
